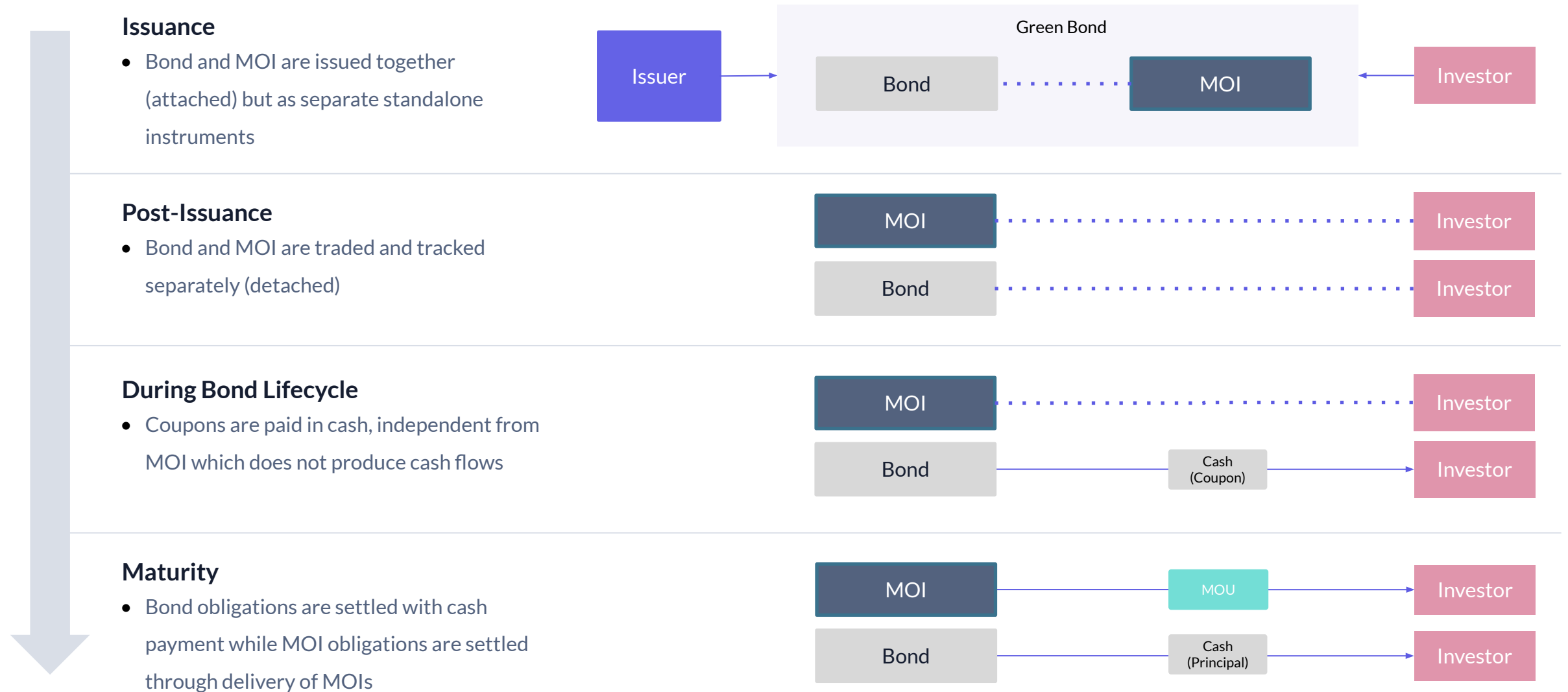

1. **New green bond structure (issuance of bond + MOI)** that use blockchain technology to track, deliver and transfer **digitalised Mitigation Outcome Interests (MOI)**
2. Prototype potentially allows:
 - a. Bodies like UNFCCC and others to supervise a digital registry for verified carbon credits to avoid issues like greenwashing and double counting
 - b. Arrangers to facilitate the digital issuance of bond and MOI
 - c. Issuers can monitor uncertified Mitigation Outcomes (MOs) and receive certified MOUs
 - d. Investors can monitor green outcomes and achieve carbon reduction goals

Listing of Vietnam Hydropower REC Project on OperaX ⚡

InterOpera is excited to announce the listing of digital Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) issued by Song Giang Hydropower Joint Stock Company on OperaX - InterOpera's carbon asset exchange. This is a pivotal step forward in connecting a Vietnam hydro project directly to buyers in Asia and globally.

Song Giang 1 and 2 are two run-of-river hydropower projects in cascade on the same river in the Khanh Hoa province of Vietnam. With a total capacity of 49MW, the projects will produce enough energy to power 74,000 households in Vietnam.
